Learning for the Month

As May is test month in school, we recommend that pupils continue to revise topics taught during this academic year. Below are a few recommendations:

Miss McMorris/Mrs Pattison's class:

Literacy: Phonics (P1: initial sounds, P2- CVC words and P3- CVCC/CVC words) Key words, Listening Activities and sentence dictation (P2/3)

Numeracy: Time, Money, Measure Addition and Subtraction.

Mr Beattie's class:

Literacy: Comprehension skills, Spellings, Grammar and Punctuation.

Numeracy: Times Tables, Division, Addition, Subtraction, Time, Data Handling and Measure.
